



### Academic Excellence Highlights (2024-25)

The academic year 2024-25 has been marked by outstanding scholastic achievement, reflecting the school's commitment to excellence and disciplined learning. The school proudly honoured class toppers of the previous academic year during the Christmas programme held on 23 December 2025, students from Kindergarten to the Senior classes demonstrated remarkable dedication, consistency, and intellectual rigor, achieving exceptional scores across all sections.

In UKG section, Udit Goyal secured the first position with a remarkable score of 99.78%, while Agambir Singh and Vaani achieved second position with 99.76 % and Manraj Kaur secured the third position with 99.69 percent. In Class I, Hunar Sharma of Jasmine section emerged as the class topper with an exceptional score of 99.98%, whereas Sehbaj Singh Gill of Lily section secured second position with 99.92% and Gurleen Kaur of Lily section secured the third position with 99.83%. In Class II, Sarwagya Kalia of Pansy section secured the first position with 99.98%, followed by Navisha Aggarwal of Pansy section secured second position with 99.92% and Navanya of Pansy section secured third position with 99.85%. These excellent results reflect the strong academic foundation and consistent efforts of our young learners.
